

網上購物大豐



隨著現今科技進步及互聯網發展蓬勃,加上智能電話的普及,現在 基本上所有人隨時隨地都能上網接收資訊,因而,近年亦隨了興起了新 的購物形式——網上購物。

網上購物,即顧客不用按照傳統形式親身到商店選購貨物,只需動動手指上網便能直接購買心儀的貨品。雖然少了與店主或賣家的直接交流,且增加了更多的填單及確認過程,然無可厚非的是,網上購物更加方便和適合都市人講求效率的急速生活節奏。

稱上購物風險




雖然網上購物好處不少,然而根據消費者委員會的數字,可以看到近幾年對網上購物的投訴明顯上升,特別是對貨品質素的不滿颷升甚多。究竟網上購物有何風險?

1. 貨品質素保証

消費者在網上購物,往往只能看賣家所上傳的貨品樣本,不能明確知道貨品質素如何,有些黑心商人借用這一點來欺騙消費者,如虛構這些貨品是一些外國品牌等,這從右圖(一)中的「不滿銷售手法/陳述不符」和「懷疑假貨」等投訴宗數的大幅增加,可見貨品的質素與賣家的描述有頗大落差,質素保証較實體商店低。

此外,用數碼器材所拍攝貨品的顏色與真實貨品有一定的差異,樣本會受到如燈光、手機型號等的影響。若追問店主,店主又已經列明不接受「色差」作賠償理由,這就是消費者要承受的風險。右圖(二)就是一位消費者的水瓶實物和樣本的對比,由此可見樣本與實物相差可以很大。

網上購物方式 現時流行的網購方式主要有以下幾種:



●討論區論壇:網民 可藉討論區作一平 台,與其他會員商 討買賣,部分討論 區更設有專用版面, 促進交易。

●購物網站:它是由許多提供不同商品或者服務的營業者集中在一個網站中,使用者可以在同一個網站購買不同公司所提供的商品或者服務,然後經由物流公司送到顧客家中或到指定地點取貨,如淘寶網。

消費者要在買賣網站註冊,並提供一定的個人資料,例如姓名、聯絡方法和年齡等。另外,收貨的方法主要有兩種:郵寄和面對面交收貨品。若選郵寄,當然要提供住宅地址給賣家,那該名賣家豈不是擁有該名消費者大部分個人資料?因此消費者的身份很容易被賣家盜竊作其他用途。





最大的好處當然是方便快捷。顧客不用到處走動, 更不需親身到商店選擇貨品,只要用手機或電腦上網便 能成功購得貨物。除此之外,網購還有不少優點:



1. 網上購物沒有任何時間限制

作為網路商店,它可以 24小時對客戶開放,只要 用戶在需要的時間登陸網 站,就可以在其中挑選自己 需要的商品,相較傳統已 需要的商品,相較傳統 問的限制,所以,網上客戶 即使在節日假期,仍可以安 心上網購買貨品。

即使網上貨品價格不合乎顧客的預期,大部分網上商店留有聯絡方法,顧客可與店主議價,這相比傳統商店商品的固定價格較具彈性。

網上購物注意事項



- 1. 盡量選擇商譽良好或具名氣的網上商店購物,這可參考其他網民的"好評"或"評分"之類,提防黑店。
- 2. 交易過程中不要輕易洩露個人信息,如身份證號碼及照片等,盡量只提供一些必要的資料給賣家。
- 3. 必須保留交易紀錄。

網上購物習慣太起底

為了更瞭解本校同學網購的風氣,我們向全校同學 發出了886份問卷,其中828有效。當中共有488人 表示有在網上購物的經驗,初中生佔179人,高中生佔309人,可見網購在救恩學生中也頗普遍。



同學網上購物的頻 率有幾高?花多少 錢?去哪些商店? 根據問卷調查,有近四成半的同學過去一年網購一至三次,以花費 \$300 以下佔最多。初中同學多光顧 INSTAGRAM 和淘寶,兩者都有約 6 成;高中同學較多光顧 INSTAGRAM,約有 4 成。





大家為何到 網上購物? 網上購物的同學多是因網店較實體商戶方便,其次是因為網上商品選擇較多和便宜。曾在網上購物的同學較多是受朋友的影響,廣告或社會風氣等反而與他們上網購物的關係不大。



不光顧網上店鋪的 同學有何原因? 接近半數沒有網購經驗的同學是認為網上購物較實體商店不安全,如怕貨品寄失,又或是面交時會受拐騙等。此外亦有半數同學認為網上貨品沒有保證,有可能是假貨、劣質或二手貨等。還有一點,同學認為網購程序繁複,這包括付款的程序或交收的程序等。





大家對網購 有何評價?

超過七成同學認為網購好在不受時間地區的限制,且可以隨時隨地留意自己有興趣的東西。不過亦有約七成的同學認為網購沒有保證,可見同學對網購的正負面評價各參半。



數據更顯示高中同學較初中同學注重貨品質素和購物的方便程度。



我們有同學 仔在網上經 營店舖嗎? 有一成多的同學在網上經營網上店鋪,他們的原因大多是由於個人需要、朋友影響或為了實現自己的夢想。這些同學均認為在網上經營較現實創業好,不但不用付租金,而且成本低,更是方便管理,隨時隨地都可以接訂單。



沒有經營網上店鋪的同學過半數是因沒興趣,其次約三成是因不懂管理和怕浪費時間。



原來救恩的同學對於網上購物都各有看法,但無論是網購還是經營網店都有利有弊,網購者要謹慎而行, 不要盲目相信樣本和小心交易的過程。至於經營網店者要小心入貨,避免出售劣質貨而犯下詐騙罪。
