How much do you know about Hong Kong foreign domestic helpers?

Most Hong Kong domestic helpers come from the Philippines, Indonesia and Thailand.



Common terms of foreign domestic helpers in Hong Kong:

Maids, foreign servants, fei yung, 'bun mui and bun bun

A foreign domestic helper is entitled to 12 statutory holidays in a year .

Contracts can only be for a maximum period of two years .

All foreign domestic helpers in Hong Kong should be paid not less than the minimum allowable wage of HK\$3,740 per month of their employment.

Employer must provide living accommodation.

Permission from the Housing Department is required if residents living public housing want to hire non-native servants.
